



What does stranger danger look like in today's world ON & OFF line

Training for Pupils ;Staff; & Parents

We would never suggest that young people avoid social media, but we cannot ignore the clear and present danger of harm online and offline.

Our training is focused on **CRITICAL THINKING** and the **implications and consequences** of being rash on and off line, and importantly simple ways to stay safe.

References are available and are outstanding. Our CEO, Marilyn Hawes, is a former deputy head teacher and all the work delivered is age appropriate .

The purpose of this session is:

- Change *behaviour* online AND offline and think about the consequences of making a mistake;
- Build resilience and become a good digital citizen;

Years 3 and 4 receive 30 mins regarding online strangers; grooming; settings; sexting and live streaming; consent & abuse

Year 5 and 6 have an hour and CSE and Knives and County lines are included as this age group are now being targeted

Years 7 to 11 have an hour each back to back throughout the day.

Years 12 and 13 have an hour each also to include issues of offenders, as these students may consider a career in the legal sector and come across these issue

Parents are welcome to attend in the evening for a 90 minutes session an all issues covered throughout the day at school plus more in depth on Internet and Gangs

All the full day courses include staff training after school and parents in the evening

We ALSO deliver 2 to 3 hours for a **STAFF INSET** - this half day agenda **ADDITIONALLY includes to the list below**

- The abuser – where it starts and why, how they think
- Early indicators of a potential groomer
- How grooming works on and offline

- Why don't people tell?
- Impact of CSA and how it manifests in behaviours
- Impact and harm of a youngster witnessing domestic abuse & behaviours to identify

- Peer on peer abuse
- How can I help navigate around harm online?
- What is predatory behaviour on the internet, how does the grooming work & for how long?
- How many hours sleep a night do I need to succeed at school?

- Why is my web cam a risk?
- Which games are a risk and why?
- What about my passwords?
- What is cyber bullying?
- Sexting; on line streaming abuse; Live streaming; stalking and how it works & consequences
- What are the various apps and online games needing caution?
- What does viral look like, what is the dark web / deep web / surface web?
- Weapons; knives and drugs
- Why young people join gangs
- What to spot!
- What are County Lines? What is CCE? – how can it begin
- CSE - Child Sexual Exploitation – how can it begin? What is the hook?
- The need to report
- The law
- What can I do to stay safe?
